The MedHub system allows you to **anonymously** report concerns regarding your graduate medical education at UC Davis, and/or quality of life issues which you feel have not been addressed through the normal channels available to you. There is a link to send an anonymous message directly to the DIO/GME Director on your MedHub Home Page.

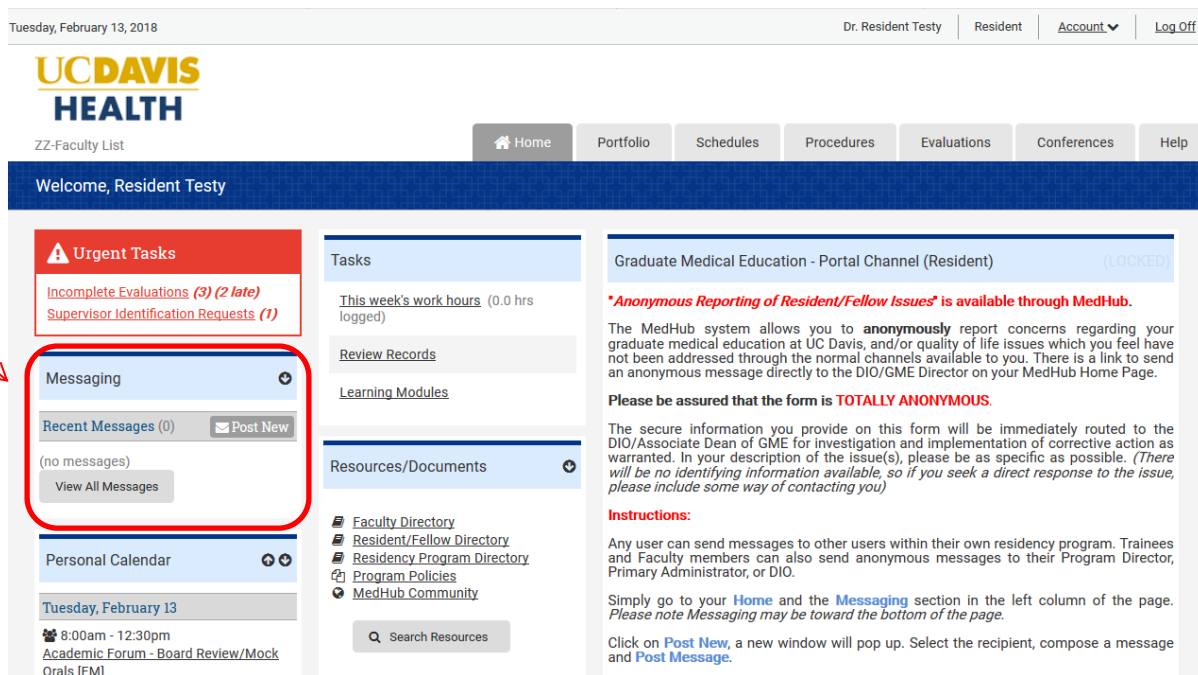
Please be assured that the form is TOTALLY ANONYMOUS.

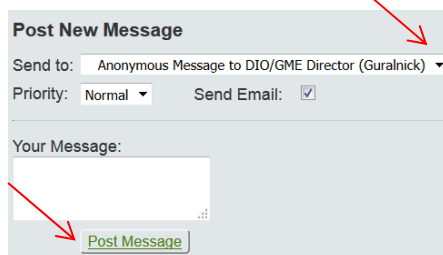
Instructions:

Any user can send messages to other users within their own residency program. Trainees and Faculty members can also send anonymous messages to their Program Director, Primary Administrator, or DIO.

Simply go to your **Home** and the **Messaging** section in the left column of the page. *Please note Messaging may be toward the bottom of the page.*



Click on **Post New**, a new window will pop up. **Select the Recipient**, compose a message and **Post Message**.



Users sending messages may also send an email to the recipient by clicking on the **'Send Email' checkbox**. This posts the message to the user's home page and sends that same message via email to their specified default email account.
