PURPOSE

With a looming nursing shortage, an aging faculty workforce with anticipated nursing faculty retirements, and implementation of a pre-licensure nursing education program, preparation of the next generation of educators is an important issue for the Betty Irene Moore School of Nursing as well as the larger Sacramento nursing community.

The Graduate Academic Certificate Program as Health Professions Education (HPE-GAC) will focus on preparing students in graduate programs who have an interest in health professions education to be able to serve as educators in health professions, particularly in nursing.

WHO CAN APPLY

- Students who already have a bachelor's degree and are enrolled in the MS-L or PhD program of the School of Nursing's graduate programs.
- Students enrolled in a UC Davis graduate program with an interest in health professions education may also apply and will be admitted on a space available basis.

Potential applicants should apply for the certificate program when they have completed at least one quarter of graduate education in one of the Nursing Science and Health-Care Leadership graduate programs.

QUALIFICATIONS TO APPLY

Criteria used to determine admission of students:

- Current student in the MS-L or PhD programs of the Nursing Science and Health-Care Leadership Graduate group programs, or consent of the HPE-GAC Chair;
- In good academic standing (at least 3.0 GPA);
- Successful completion of one quarter of graduate education.
